Location and Name

The course takes its name from **Annie Laurie Lake**, which itself has a long history in the region.

- **Setting:** The course is integrated into a larger recreation area that includes a nature/bird trail system, a beach, and a wildlife campground.

Pioneers of the Meadows

The fact that the golf course was designed to use the **natural landscape** is a direct nod to the way the land was originally kept by the pioneer families—preserving the contours and beauty of the meadows rather than flattening them.

The history and current status of **Annie Laurie Meadows Golf Course**, incorporating those community-driven details:

A Community-Built Landmark

The development of Annie Laurie Meadows is a testament to the **Preeceville community's** DIY spirit. Rather than hiring outside contractors, the **Preeceville Economic Development Committee** leaned into the skills and time of its volunteers to bring the project to life.

- **Volunteer Effort:** Hundreds of volunteer hours have been logged, designing, shape the fairways, and manage the site. This hands-on approach has kept the project rooted in the local identity.
- **Donated Equipment:** To keep overhead low and ensure the project's viability, the machinery and tools used to build and maintain the course were acquired entirely through local donations.
- **Natural Landscape Design:** The course layout wasn't forced onto the land; it was "nestled" into the existing topography. It sits strategically adjacent to Annie Laurie Lake and the **renowned Lions Family Trail**, allowing golfers to experience the same scenic wildlife and boreal beauty that hikers on the trail enjoy.

Connection to the Lions Family Trail

The integration with the **Lions Family Trail** is a key part of its history. By placing the course adjacent to this established landmark, the developers created a multi-use recreational corridor. This proximity helps protect the local ecosystem while providing a "park-like" atmosphere for golfers, distinct from the more manicured, artificial feel of urban courses.

It is rare to find a community that has successfully packed such a diverse range of recreation into one "backyard" footprint. The way the **Annie Laurie Meadows Golf Course** connects to the lake and trails creates a seamless flow for a full day of activity without ever needing to leave the area.

The "All-in-One" Family Getaway

Based on the layout and the recent efforts by the **Preeceville EDC**, **Lions Club**, and **Preeceville Wildlife Club** here is how that "**complete family outing**" looks today:

- **Adventure on the Trails:** The **Lions Family Trail** (and the Nature-Bird Trail) isn't just for walking; it's a multi-use corridor. In the summer, it's perfect for a family bike ride or a shaded hike. In the winter, the new **ski chalet (warm-up shack)** and groomed cross-country tracks keep the area active year-round.
- **The Beach & Water Hub:** Annie Laurie Lake features a **sandy beach** that has been a focal point for the town's revitalization. With the **boat and kayak launch**, (donated by the Preeceville Wildlife) families can easily transition from a morning on the water to an afternoon picnic.
- **Preeceville EDC Playground:** Strategically placed near the beach, the playground equipment (funded in part by a major donation from the Lions Club) ensures that younger children have a dedicated space to play while parents relax nearby.
- **Wildlife Connection:** The **Preeceville Wildlife Campground** is just a three-minute walk away. For those visiting from out of town—or locals wanting a "**staycation**"—having 10 electrical sites so close to the golf course and beach makes it one of the most convenient and affordable camping spots in the region.
- **Donation-Based Play:** Instead of a set \$50 or \$100 fee, players contribute what they can to a dedicated **donation box**. These funds are funneled directly back into maintenance and continuing the course development.
- Generous Donation of Golf Club/bags/and pull carts Shannon Prestie and Shannon Nelson available to rent
- Ralph & Lynn Ager long term land lease agreement along with the Town of Preeceville. Thank you.

Why It Works

The true "magic" of Annie Laurie Meadows and the surrounding park is the **affordability**. By keeping the golf course volunteer-run and the trails open to the public, the community has removed the "paywall" that often keeps families away from high-end resorts. It's a high-quality experience built by neighbors, for neighbors.

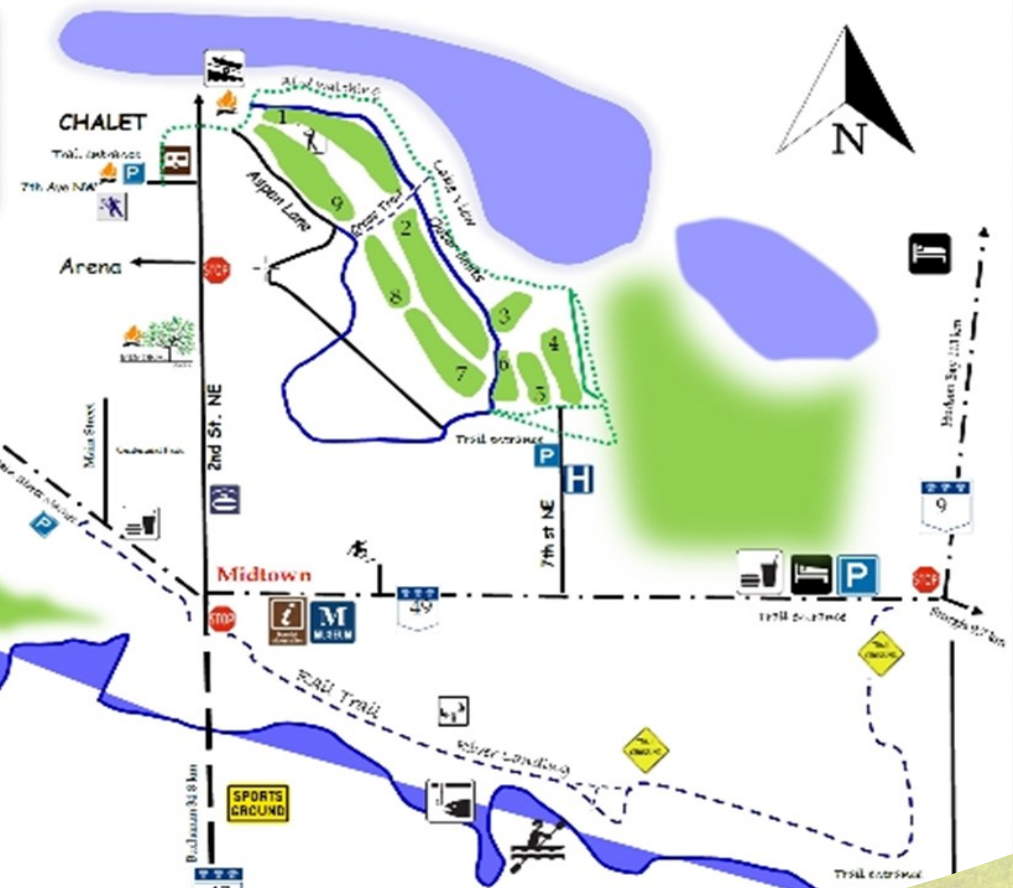
