The Village of Buchanan is exploring a small pilot project to support responsible pet ownership in our community.

The Village is considering a voluntary “Animal Educator” role. This would be an educational position only, focused on sharing information, promoting bylaw awareness by explaining the bylaw as well as positive communication between neighbours.

****It would not involve enforcement or bylaw authority****

As part of this pilot exploration, the Village is asking residents for feedback:

Would this type of volunteer role be helpful in our community

Do you have suggestions for what an educational role should include

Would you be interested in volunteering in a non-enforcement capacity

Residents are invited to submit comments to the Village Office or express interest in participating.

Your feedback will help Council determine whether to move forward with this pilot concept.

By focusing on education, the Village can:

Avoid the cost of enforcement contracts

Keep animal control fees stable

Reduce the need for tax increases

Improve compliance through community engagement

It is the Villages hope that this approach would support a safer, more informed community without the the burden of additional costs to ratepayer

Council Updates:

The Lot amalgamation policy for taxation purposes policy -

If all properties that meet the criteria apply for the amalgamation for taxation purposes and Council permits the application(s), it could potentially lead to a loss in revenue for the Village of over \$20,000.00 As property taxes are the main source of revenue - this loss would impact ALL property taxes in 2025 and would result in a tax increase for ALL properties. Council is currently reviewing this policy to ensure decisions are made in the best interests of the Village and you the ratepayers. ✨

A comparison of vacant land property taxes was completed for municipalities in 2024. The Village of Buchanan has the lowest tax structure for vacant land- at \$125 / lot for 2024. This increased to \$150 in 2025. Similar villages with populations ranging from 190- 280 have a vacant lot tax ranging from \$400-\$800.

•Special levies such as the garbage and recycling levy were used in 22 other municipalities in Saskatchewan in 2024. Some examples of such levies are:

- Library Levy (\$11.10)
- garbage (\$100)
- economic development (((\$118)
- Utility levy (100), waste collection (100)
- lagoon construction (120)
- economic development (118)
- garbage and recycling (160)
- sewer levy (250)
- library levy (25)
- sport and culture levy (90)
- infrastructure (300)
- garbage (270)

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Bylaws & Policies

Village Council will be working on the Villages very outdated Bylaws. Just a reminder that in 2024, Bylaws were reviewed and over 30 outdated Bylaws were repealed. Currently there are a number of Bylaws from the 1970 - early 2000's that will need updating. To update a bylaw - a significant amount of time is spent researching other municipalities bylaws, connecting with the Ministry as well as ensuring the bylaw meets legislation. Ensuring the bylaw is a good match for the Village is also taken into consideration. This is all done prior to presenting to council. 1 Bylaw can take upwards of 6 hours of Administration time to prepare before going to Council for the 3 reads needed to pass the bylaw. Council appreciates your patience while this very important task is undertaken.

Just a friendly reminder that the Village has a Zero Tolerance Policy in effect. This policy will be posted for residents to review. Please note - this policy applies to all Village employees, including Council as well as contractors working in the Village. This policy ensures everyone can do their jobs in a safe work environment and is legislated by the Province.

In 2025, the Village received 71 888.00 from the Provincial Government for Revenue Sharing. If in the future this program changes, an increase to property taxes of approximately \$326.00 would result in order for the Village to continue to operate independently. Additional income (savings) is extremely important to ensure the Village has funds saved to be able to continue as an independent Municipality should things change with this Provincial Grant.
